FULL ENQUIRY NEEDED INTO A.W.C. IN **QUEENSLAND**

The Government has acceded to requests for an enquiry into certain aspects of the workings of the A.W.C. in Sydney. The enquiry is now proceeding, and its results should make for a more efficient contribution to the war effort.

However, the terms of reference of the enquiry are too limited.

The Queensland Trades Congress, the Queensland T. and L. Council and the Building Trades Council Unions have all called for a complete enquiry into the workings of the A.W.C., especially in Queensland. The Building Trades Unions have asked that at least one member of the unions sit on the Commission.
