"THIRDLY, the great democratic Powers have pledged
themselves to co-operate to
maintain peace and security
after the war. The cause of

triumphed. Moscow and Teheran have avenged Madrid and
Munich.

"A more peaceful approach to Socialism becomes possible. It hecomes possible because, with the crushing of Fascism the ruling classes will have less power to resist the will of the people by violence.
