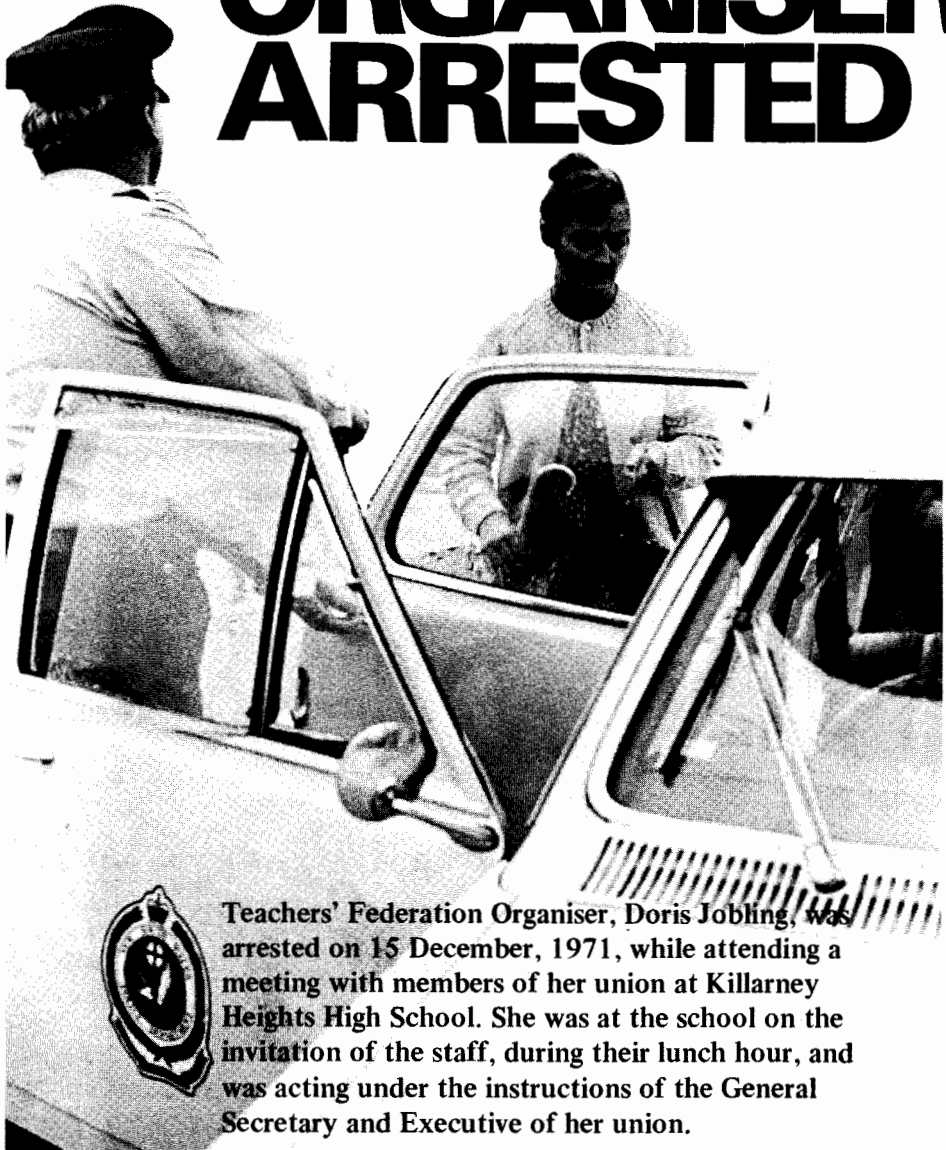


# UNION ORGANISER ARRESTED

### The crime

A Union organiser was called by her members to the job to inform them of current Union policy at a lunchtime meeting. She was there with the authorisation of the Union Executive and in the company of the General Secretary.

This was what Doris Jobling was doing on

December 15th, 1971 when she was arrested at Killarney Heights High School.

### The arrest

Police entered the room, disrupted the Union meeting and arrested the official.

### The charge

The charge was laid by the Principal

under Section 50(1) of the Summary Offences Act which states:

"A person who enters or remains in or upon any part of a building or structure, or any land occupied or used in connection therewith, and has no reasonable cause for so doing is guilty of an offence."

*Penalty: Two hundred dollars or imprisonment for three months.*

### The implication

Contact with Union officials is a right of all Union members and any threat to this right endangers the ability of members to organise and act through their Union. Unless this right of contact is maintained without the threat of police action, the possibility of effective union action will be destroyed.
