## RULES

OF THE
vi. The headquarters of the League shall be in Perth. Members not associated with any branch shall pay their subscription direct to the Treasurer of the Council.
vil. The management of the League shall be vested in a President, six Vice-Prestdents, a Treasurer, a General Secretary, a Recording Secretary, and a Council, the Council to consist of members and delegates. Members (not less than nine) to be elected at the annual general meeting of the League. Delegates to be elected by the branches as hereafter provided. Casual vacancies to be filled by the Council.
viII. The Council shall have power to elect not more than three additional Vice-Presidents.
IX. The management of a branch shall be vested in a Committee, to be elected by members of the branch, who may also elect a delegate to represent them on the Conncil.
x. The President may, through the Secretary, call special meetings of the Council when she may deem it. necessary, or in response to a written request of any three members of the Council. She shall perform all other duties usual to such office.
xI. The secretary of each Branch shall, during the last quarter of the Leagne's financial year, send to the General Secretary of the League a complete list of the names and addresses of every member of the branch, accompanied by the remittance of sixpence for each member, as provided in Rule $v$. The League's financial year shall end on May 31st. The General Secretary of the League shall keep a register of all members of the League, and also arouse interest during the year by literature and correspondeuce with local branches.
xII. The Recording Secretary shall attend all meetings of the Council and keep a correct report of their proceedings. . She shall send to each member of the Council a proper notice of each meeting, and designate in such notice the topics which are to be specially considered at the meeting. *he shall apprise members of Committee of their appointments, and shall perform all other duties pertaining to that office.
XIII. The Treasurer shall collect and receive all monies due to the Council, and keep, accurate accounts of all receipts and disbursements, and present a detailed report thereof to each annual meeting. She shall pay no monies except on an order signed by the President and Secretary. The financial year shall terminate one week previous to the annual meeting, when the books will be closed.
xiv. No alteration shall be made in this Constitution except notice be first given to the Secretary one month prior to the general meeting at which sach alteration is proposed to be made.
xv. General meetings may be held at any time at the direction of the Council.
XVI. All questions at any meeting of members or of the Council shall be determined by a majority of those present.
XVII. For general meetings the quorum shall be not less than twelve, and for the Council the quoram shall not be less than five.
