esistance is a group of young people just like you. Sure, we've got big ideas. We're against war, injustice and inequality, and we think that socialism is necessary to achieve an end to these things.

Is socialism just a dream? We don't think so. Over one third of the world's people live in countries that have overthrown capitalism. Others have had revolutions that are moving in that direction.

A good example is the Sandinistas in Nicaragua. Nicaragua had a popular revolution back in 1979. Under the leadership of the Sandinistas the Nicaraguan people kicked the United States and its puppet government out of their country. Since then they have been trying to rebuild their

country free of oppression and exploitation. The big problem has been that the United States just doesn't like the example Nicaragua is setting. Now the US is preparing to invade Nicaragua to "reestablish democracy." We support the Sandinistas and the achievements of the Nicaraguan revolution.

r maybe you've heard of Fidel Castro and what's happened in Cuba since the revolution there in 1959. This is an example of another revolution we like and work to defend.

Anyone can join Resistance, well just about anyone. There are two criteria. First of all you have to be young, and secondly you have to like big ideas.
